Fire Chief Mike Tapp gave an Sgt. Butch Clarke spoke about several Orange County update on the NHVFD and Sheriff Office community safety services. emergency services.

- 2. Orange County Emergency Services has entered into an agreement with the fire department to house an EMS ambulance at station 2 during peak load hours from 1:00pm until 1:00am daily to reduce emergency response time for the New Hope area.
- 3. Possibility for emergency shelter designation is being investigated for the NHIA Community Center.
